

Strand 2 - Creating Film:

Student Learning Goals

The filmmaking project is a group activity and each group member has a role to play. Making a film is a fun and rewarding experience, but only if everyone shares the responsibilities and works together!

In this strand we will...

Pre-Production

- Pitch ideas for our film project.
- Listen to others' film ideas and agree the best idea for our film project.
- Use our understanding of film language to script and storyboard our film project.
- Take on different roles and responsibilities at each stage of the filmmaking process.
- Cast our film.
- Source all the necessary equipment and learn how to use it in advance.
- Plan a film shoot, including budgets, schedules, locations, equipment, costumes and props.
- Consider any health and safety issues that might arise.

Production

- Use our understanding of film language to make a film.
- Work together as a team.
- Come up with creative solutions to any problems which arise on set.
- Have fun!

Post-Production

- Edit the film and assist with organising any extra overdubbing, music or effects.

Strand 2a - Share

- Work together to organise an in-class film festival.
- Reflect on both strands in a reflection note.
- Decide how to present our film to our class, explaining our inspiration, ideas, challenges and successes.
- Present the film to your class.
- Show respect when watching others' films and offer positive feedback and encouragement.

I will use my film notebook to...

- Keep a record of my role and my responsibilities at each stage of the filmmaking process, and any deadlines I need to meet.
- Keep a copy of scripts, schedules and budgets and ensure that we are managing them well.
- List any equipment, costumes, or props we need for each day on set.
- Keep a record of footage we shoot for when we come to the editing process.
- Reflect on the experience of making a film with a group.
