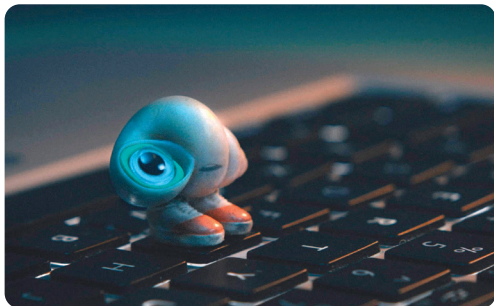
## Tales From Dún Draoícha: Meet The Makers
